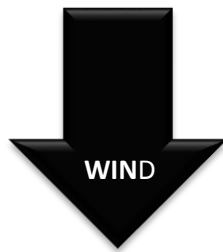


SBSC Race Management Racing Courses:



COURSES:

First Race: Should be a Triangle, route indicated by BLUE line

Second Race:

Should be a windward/leeward course. (The Gybe mark should be removed and the windward leg extended)

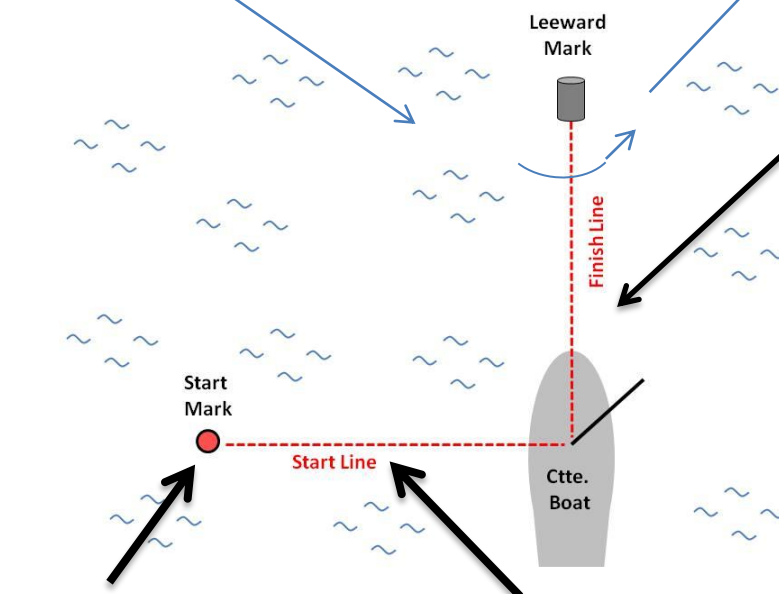
NOTE: All courses should be **port hand** wherever possible (anti-clockwise)

One of the downwind legs should be at a **deeper angle** than the other to give all boats a fair chance

The Windward Leg should be a good length and the average boat should be going upwind for 10 – 15 Minutes (length will vary depending on wind speed)

Each Lap should take about 12-15 minutes for the lead boat, with the race continuing until the fastest boat has reached the target race time (40-45 minutes)

The committee boat should be positioned approximately 20 yards to leeward of the leeward mark, no more or it makes it hard to read the sail numbers.



The Start Line length should be the number of boats x 1.5 boat lengths (E.G 4 darts and 2 RS700's – approximately 100 feet = start line 150 feet long)

The Start Line should be at approximately 90 degrees to the wind and enable boats to sail across on **Starboard** tack easily.
