NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

The regatta will be governed by

- 1.1. the rules as defined in The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 - 2020.
- 1.2. The rules of the 2000 Class Association
- 1.3. The sailing instructions
- 1.4. RYA prescriptions
- 1.5. The Exoneration Penalty (and the Advisory Hearing and Arbitration procedures) of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedure will be available.

1 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 1.1. At least one member of a boats crew must be a current member of the 2000 Class Association.
- 1.2. Eligible boats may enter by
 - 1.2.1. completing an Entry Form and sending it, with the required fee to:- Adrian Tebbutt, 58 Woodland Gardens, North Wootton, King's Lynn, PE30 3PX. to be received by 24th August 2017
 - 1.2.2. completing an entry form at the club at least 1 hour before the advertised start of the first race

- 1.1 Each boat shall be sailed by the same helm and nominated crew(s) throughout the series. Substitution of competitors will not be allowed without prior written approval of the race committee.
- 1.2 **Parent/Guardian Declarations:** All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either by post or at registration.

2 FEES

Entry fee per boat: £30.00 Entry for one day only £17.50

Entry fees for Youth competitors (*aged under 21 years in full-time education on 31st August 2017*):-

Helm only: £20

Helm & Crew: £15

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 **Registration:**

(1.a) Competitors shall register in the SBSC clubhouse between the following times:
Saturday 26th August 07.30 – 13.00, Sunday 27th August 07.30 – 08.30, Monday 28th August
08.00 – 09.30

- 3.2 **Dates of racing and races scheduled:**

Six races are scheduled.

Sunday 27th August – 3 races

Monday 28th August – 3 races

- 3.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on :-
Sunday 27th August is 09.05hrs and on Monday 28th August tba

4 MEASUREMENTS

Boats and equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules.

5 SPONSOR ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising supplied by the organising authority.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration, on the 2000 Association website, and the Snettisham Beach Sailing Club website.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(1.a) When four to six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee

9 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & LIKENESSES

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat and its helm and crew are fit to sail in the conditions that they might find. By launching or going afloat competitors confirm their boat is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event and include the organizing authority, race committee, race officer, safety officer, patrol boat personnel and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.

11 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2million per event or the equivalent.

12 FURTHER INFORMATION

- 12.1 Refreshments will be available after racing each day
- 12.2 Evening meals will be available on Saturday and Sunday, please check the club website and pre-book if possible
- 12.3 Entertainment will be provided Sunday evening.
- 12.4 Limited on-site camping is available over the weekend, on a first-come-first-served basis.
