Welcome to the new sailing season and, once again, we have a full and exciting, programme of sailing and social events for all our members in 2010.

Enclosed is your Renewal Form, Working Party Sheet and a new Volunteer Sheet. Please complete the Renewal Form **in full** and return it and the others with payment. Please note that, this season, **there is a surcharge of £20 for any renewals received after 31st March 2010.**

Shortly after receipt of payment you will receive your Membership Pack with Junior Kick-Start and Cadet Week application forms. You may **not** sign up for any courses until your membership has been confirmed and your 2010 membership number issued.

Cadet Week 2010 is Monday 16th - Friday 20th August 2010. Once you have received your Membership Pack, please return forms for Cadet Week and Junior Kick-Start, with payment, to Katie Daniels. These are very popular events, with limited numbers, so places will be allocated on a first paid/first come basis.

Boat Park spaces/Topper mast storage. These are allocated as soon as your payment is received. If your boat and/or mast was left at SBSC over the winter, please remove it immediately, otherwise you will have to pay a £15 fee for winter storage. If **boats and masts are not removed by March 1st**, they will be moved to a central compound. If not claimed by 1st May the club will dispose of them according to club rule No 8.4(b). The boat parks and mast storage are available for the sailing season at a cost of £15.00 each. If you wish to keep your boat at the club all year, please double the park fee to £30.

Until membership is granted, prospective members may be guests of the Club and use all facilities providing the Commodore or Sailing Secretary has approved. The daily sailing membership fee for non-members is £7.
